



Museum is dedicated to many well-known Russian poets and composers from the gold and silver ages (such as Pushkin, Lermontov, Tsvetaeva, Mandelstam, Pasternak, Akhmatova, and Gumilev, and such composers as Tchaikovsky, Rachmaninoff, Stravinsky, Shostakovich, Prokofiev).



Museum exhibits materials from over 25 other Russian literary and musical museums and private collections.



The collection of the museum is very diverse, with more than 30 exhibits. The museum presents books, articles, video and audio recordings, materials from symposiums, conferences, readings, paintings, posters, photographs, autographs, memoirs, interviews, gifts, and translations of Russian poetry into English, German, French, Ukrainian, Hebrew, and Yidish.
